

// CALL FOR CANDIDACIES FOR CED BOARD ELECTIONS IN NOVEMBER 2018

The mandates of four members of the CED Board of Directors come to an end this November, so in accordance with Article 18.3 of the CED Statutesⁱ, elections will be held at the General Meeting on 16 November 2018 for these positions for a period of three years (i.e. until November 2021).

The following positions will therefore be open for election:

Position	Current holder
President:	Dr Marco Landi (Italy) – first mandate, eligible for re-election
Director:	Dr Piret Väli (Estonia) – first mandate, eligible for re-election
Director:	Dr Alexander Tolmeijer (Netherlands) – second mandate, not eligible for re-election
Director:	Dr Hans Schrangl (Austria) – first mandate, eligible for re-election

A. Who may apply?

In accordance with Article 18.3.1 of the CED Statutes:

- Candidates must be dental practitioners;
- Candidates must be members of a national dental association that is a full member association of the CED (members of observer associations are not eligible for election); and,
- There shall be a maximum of one member of the Board of Directors per member country.

B. How do you apply?

- Candidates have to be proposed by their member association – this requires the President/Director of that association to write a letter of support for the candidate (not necessary for candidates who are President/Director of their national association);
- Candidates have to complete the attached application form (for President or Director in English, French or German) and required annexes;
- Applications must be sent in electronic form to the Brussels office by 1 November and will be put on CED Website by 6 November for consideration by CED Members; and,
- Candidacies must be submitted in one of the official languages of the CED – English, French or German.
